SUBJECT: 2010-2011 Maximum Expenditure for Nonpublic School Transportation  
2010-2011 Maximum Increase in Transportation Contract Renewals

The maximum allowable per student expenditure for nonpublic school transportation for the 2010-2011 school year is \$884.00 or a daily rate of \$4.91 (\$884 divided by 180). The daily rate applies when the student's application is received after the start of school or when the student withdraws from the nonpublic school before the close of the school year.

Pursuant to N.J.S.A. 18A:39-3, the maximum negotiated Consumer Price Index (CPI) increase in transportation contracts for the 2010-2011 school year is 0 percent. Despite the lack of a CPI increase, renewal contracts may still increase according to the adjustment provisions contained in the original bid (such as additional mileage cost).
