Subject: New Bus Inspection Sticker Advisory

Date: March 1, 2013

Please be advised the New Jersey Motor Vehicle Commission Bus Unit has designed a new Bus Inspection Sticker that will be put into service March 1, 2013. The new sticker (attached) will be used for both School Bus and Commercial Bus operations.

The sticker was designed to create a more streamline sticker for buses and thus allow the flexibility of using one sticker which will be more cost effective rather having two separate designs as we currently use at a higher cost.

Please notice on the attached sticker sample, a check block is incorporated within the sticker design to indicate whether the bus is inspected and approved for school bus use, commercial bus use, or both school bus and commercial bus use.

A hole will be punched by MVC inspection personnel at time of inspection approval in the appropriate block that applies to the bus operation. The sticker will expire the last day of the month displayed on the front of the sticker.

Although the sticker expires at the end of the month, inspections will still be scheduled throughout the month by MVC bus teams as we currently do and buses must be presented when scheduled.
