Topics:

“Challenging Behavior: What it Means and What to Do”

The goal of this workshop is intended to provide the basic information about all different types of challenging behaviors which will ensure the safe transport of all students. The presenter will use reflective activities, turn and share conversations and situational sharing.

Workshop learning objectives include the following:

- Gain a better understanding of behavior as “stress behaviors”
- Recognize the 5 different domains of impact
- Learn about Self-Regulation vs Self-Control
- Develop strategies to reduce & eliminate problem behaviors

Presenter: **Dr. Gloria Andrade, Ph.D.**

Dr. Gloria Andrade is currently working at the Center for Autism and Early Childhood Mental Health at Montclair State University. She is a Lead Early Childhood Consultation Specialist under SEFI (Socio-Emotional Formation Initiative). She has a Ph.D. in Family Studies and Human Development. She fulfills the requirements for the endorsement by the New Jersey Association of Infant Mental Health. She holds the following certificates: Applied, Advance and Intensive Fellowship in Infant and Early Childhood Mental Health, Circle of Security, Pyramid Model, Brazelton, Expert DIRFloortime training leader, Self-Reg Foundations Program Core Competencies, Brain Story, the 12 core concepts of understanding traumatic stress responses in children and families. She is a member of the SEFI team that offers trainings throughout the state of NJ for caregivers and professionals who are working with children. In 2018, she presented at the congress of Psychology in Bogota, Colombia and in the years 2020 and 2021 at the ICDL DIRFloortime International Conference. She is bilingual in English/Spanish.

DIRECTIONS

Northern Burlington Middle School – 180 Mansfield Road, Columbus, NJ 08022

From North Jersey

Take the NJ Turnpike South to Exit 7. After exiting the Turnpike, proceed south on Route 206 approximately 2.3 miles. Turn left onto White Pine Road and follow to fork in the road. Take right hand fork (North Island Road) and follow to Mansfield Road East. Make a left onto Mansfield Road East. The school is on the left side of Mansfield Road East.

From Pennsylvania

Take the Pennsylvania Turnpike to the New Jersey Turnpike. Head North to Exit 7. After exiting Turnpike, proceed south on Route 206 approximately 2.3 miles. Turn left onto White Pine Road and follow to fork in road. Take right hand fork (North Island Road) and follow to Mansfield Road East. Make left onto Mansfield Road East. The school is on the left side of Mansfield Road East.

From South Jersey

Via 206 - Proceed North on Route 206. Approximately 2 miles after passing Columbus Farmer's Market (on your left) follow right hand exit road (Atlantic Avenue) to traffic light. Turn right onto East Main Street and follow to next intersection (Island Road.) Turn left onto Island Road and follow to Mansfield Road East. Turn right onto Mansfield Road East. The school is on the left side of Mansfield Road East.

Via 68 – Proceed North on Route 68 past Mansfield Road East. Turn left at White Pine Road. Follow White Pine to North Island Road. Make a sharp left onto North Island Road and follow to Mansfield Road East. The school is on the left side of Mansfield Road East.

Via 295 – Proceed North on Route 295 and take Exit 52, Columbus. Proceed East on County Route 656. After passing straight through the first stop light, County Route 656 changes into County Route 543. Continue on 543. After traveling approximately 2.4 miles from Exit 52 you will reach the traffic light in the center of Columbus. Proceed straight until the next intersection (Island Road.) Make a left onto Island Road and follow to Mansfield Road East. Turn right onto Mansfield Road East. The school is on the left side of Mansfield Road East.

Via the NJ Turnpike – Take the NJ Turnpike North to Exit 7. After exiting the Turnpike, proceed south on Route 206 approximately 2.3 miles. Make left onto White Pine Road and follow to fork in the road. Take right hand fork (North Island Road) and follow to Mansfield Road East. The school is on the left side of Mansfield Road.

VIA 295

Proceed South on Route 295, take Route 42 South. Proceed to Rt 55 South. Take Exit 43, Little Mill Road.

Make a left at the stop sign. Take a Right onto Rt 47 South (Red light) approximately 3 miles, Caroline L Reutter School will be on your left.

VIA the NJ Turnpike

Take the NJ Turnpike South to Exit 3. SR-42 S Runnemede; SR55 S Deptford, Take Exit 43, Little Mill Road

Make a left at the stop sign. Take a Right onto Rt 47 South (Red light) approximately 3 miles, Caroline L Reutter School will be on your left.

From the East

Rt 80 W

Rt 80 W to Rt 23 N. Follow Service Road exit to Taylor Dr. Make a right Rt on Taylor, follow to end. Make a Rt on PAL Dr. Follow PAL to the end.

Rt 46 W

Rt 46 E to Rt 23 N, get off on the Service Rd. Pass the West Belt exit approx. ¼ mile to Taylor Dr. Make a right onto Taylor to PAL, go to end rt on PAL follow to the end

From the West

Rt 80 E

Exit onto Rt 46 E, U-Turn at Riverview Dr to Rt 46 W. to Rt 23 N. Follow Service Road exit to Taylor Dr. Make a right Rt on Taylor, follow to end. Make a Rt on PAL Dr. Follow PAL to the end. (There is no exit to Rt 23N from Rt 80)

Rt 46 E

Rt 46 W to Rt 23 N, bear right onto Service Road exit to Taylor Dr. Make a right Rt on Taylor, follow to end. Make a Rt on PAL Dr. Follow PAL to the end.

From the North

Take 287 S to 80 E or 46 E U-Turn at Riverview Dr to Rt 46 W. to Rt 23 N. Follow Service Road exit to Taylor Dr. Make a right Rt on Taylor, follow to end. Make a Rt on PAL Dr. Follow PAL to the end.

Garden State Parkway S to Rt's 46 or 80W, follow above directions.

For all above directions if you miss the Service Road exit, take the next exit for Mountain View Blvd, Taylor drive will be almost directly across to the left.

Rt 23 S

Get off at Mountain View exit. Make a right at the light onto Mountain View Blvd (Grasshopper will be on you left at the light) Follow around to the traffic light at Parish Dr. Make the left onto Parish and bear right immediately onto PAL Dr, follow to the end.

Once on PAL Dr, pass the PAL building and ball fields on your right, there will be train tracks on your left, continue to the end, you'll see the buses. There's a small foot bridge to the office building.
